

**NORTH UNIT IRRIGATION DISTRICT  
JEFFERSON COUNTY, OREGON  
ORDINANCE NO. 2006-09**

An Ordinance regarding North Unit Irrigation District water rights which adds to the provisions of Ordinance No. 06-07 and Ordinance No. 06-08.

**Recitals:**

The Board of Directors of the North Unit Irrigation District (NUID), Jefferson County, Oregon, have determined that subdivisions and/or partitions having all of the parcels or lots of greater than five acres creates a problem for delivery of irrigation water from the delivery point to a parcel that is not connected to the delivery point.

**Findings:**

The Board of Directors has determined that a landowner or developer, when creating two or more parcels from one parcel in which each of the new parcels or lots are more than five acres has created in the past a problem with delivery of water to a parcel that is not connected to the delivery point.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors as follows:

1. It shall be the policy of the North Unit Irrigation District at the time a subdivision or a partition is created, consisting of all of the lots or parcels being greater than five acres, the landowner or developer shall commit to furnishing the irrigation delivery(s) to each lot or parcel by establishing a delivery point with a measuring device approved by NUID to the parcel(s) that do (does) not have a delivery point. The landowner or developer shall be responsible for all the costs of establishing the deliveries and shall be responsible for providing or obtaining the irrigation water easements to each delivery point.
2. This ordinance replaces Ordinance No. 2006-04.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Directors.


