RESOLUTION TO AMEND RULES AND REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors adopted Rules and Regulations Governing the Distribution and Use of Water in the North Unit Irrigation District on March 12, 2019 (the "2019 Rules and Regulations"), pursuant to the Irrigation District Law, Oregon Revised Statutes ("ORS") Chapter 545, including ORS 545.221(1).

WHEREAS, since at least 1985, the policy of the North Unit Irrigation District has been to impose a 0.1 cubic foot per second minimum on water orders (the "Minimum Order Policy"). This policy is necessary to manage water deliveries in the most efficient and cost-effective manner, which benefits the district as a whole.

WHEREAS, the Minimum Order Policy was inadvertently omitted from the 2019 Rules and Regulations, and the Board of Directors desires to amend the 2019 Rules and Regulations to incorporate the Minimum Order Policy.

BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Unit Irrigation District Board of Directors, pursuant to the Irrigation District Law and ORS 545.221(1), hereby amends the 2019 Rules and Regulations to add the following Section 11.e:

Minimum Orders. With the exception of orifice deliveries, water orders shall be for a minimum of 0.10 cfs. A water order for less than 0.10 cfs shall be deemed an order of 0.10 cfs and charged accordingly.

THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY UPON ADOPTION BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS.
